toys he ignores.

There is one thing in the house that has caught his interest, because there are living creatures involved. Could it really be a spaceship full of aliens?


The story is set up in frames, in comic book style and is rich in colorful illustrations as Mr. Wuffles plays with the spaceship. The aliens work together to fight back and survive in order to escape. They accomplish this with the
